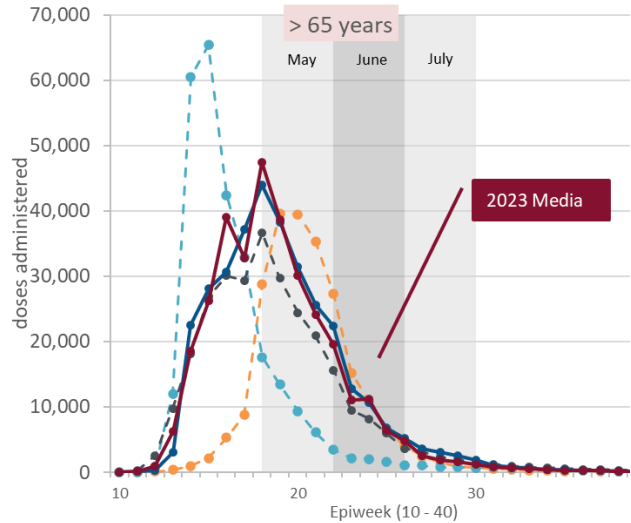

# Influenza Vaccination Uptake – by age groups



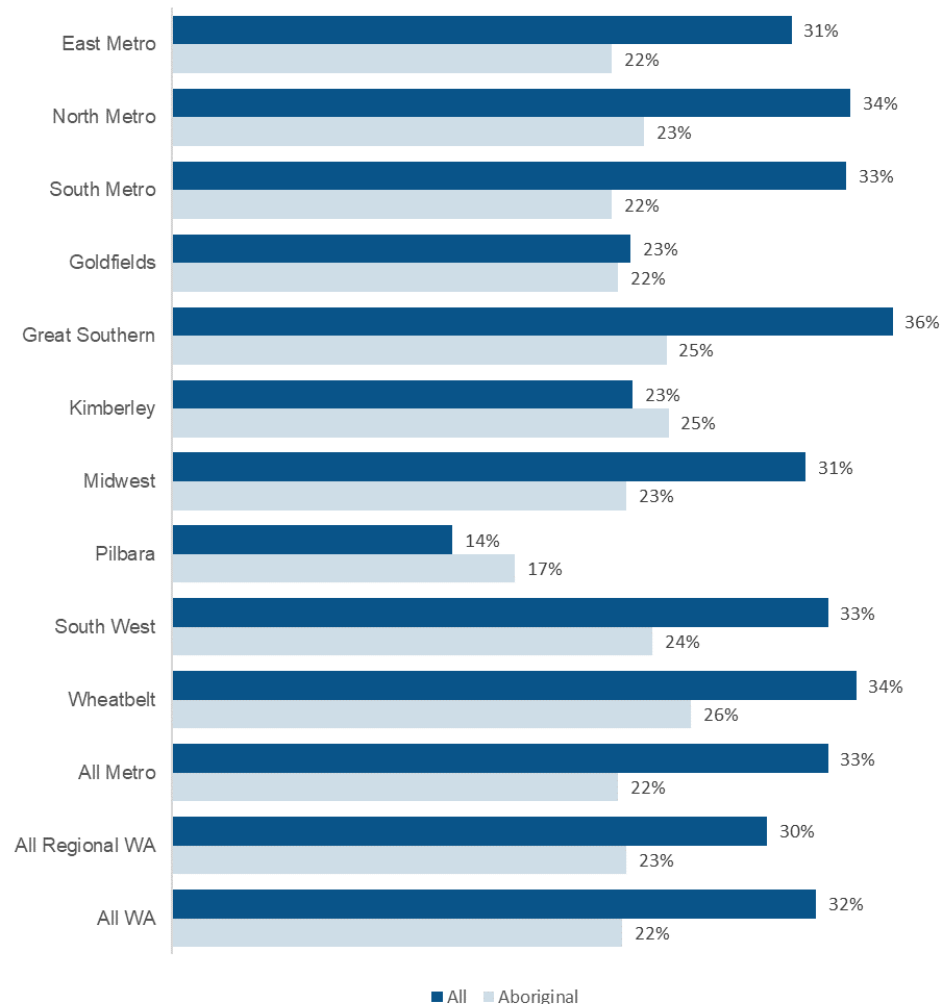

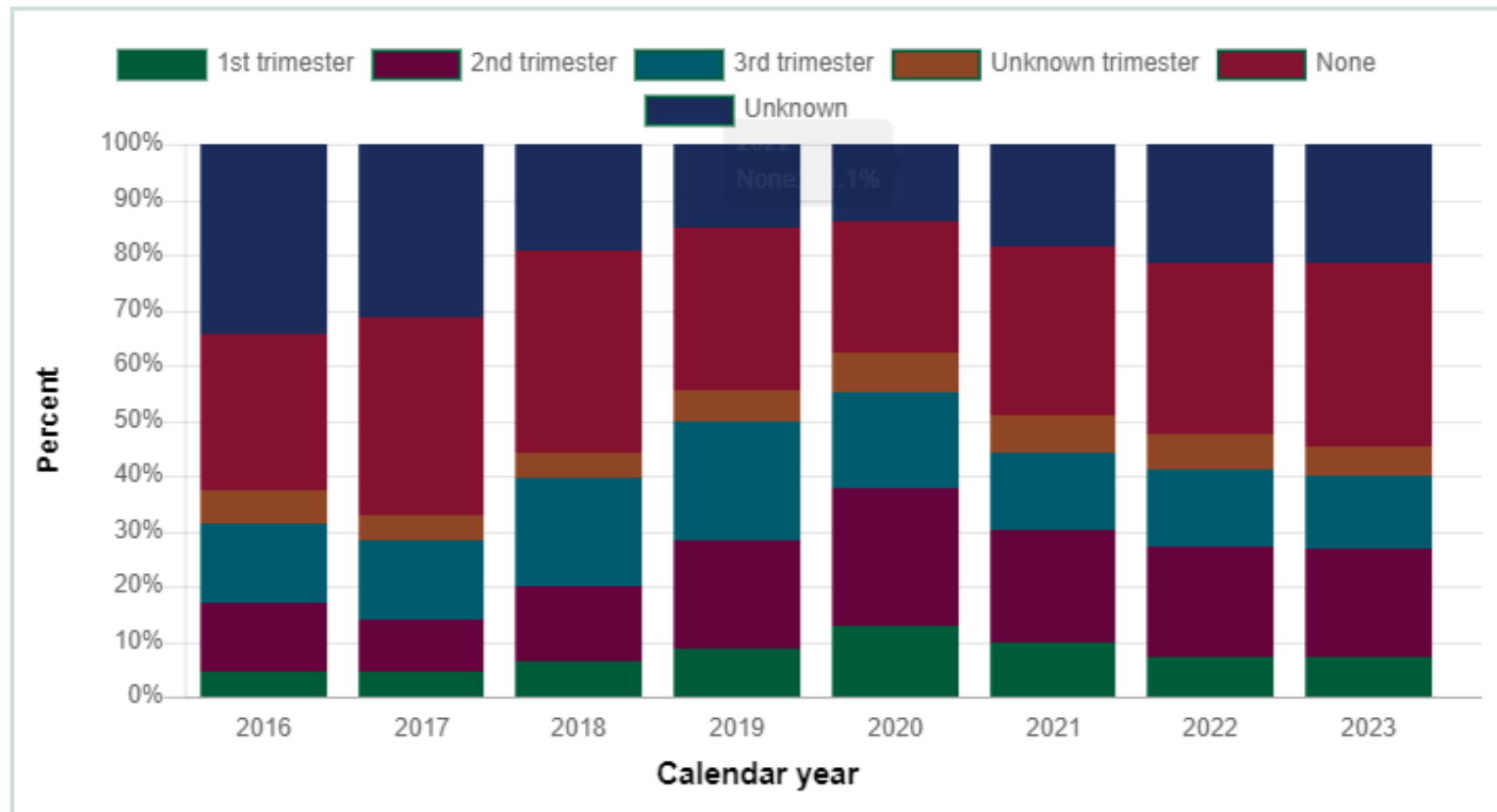
# Influenza Immunisation Coverage – by region

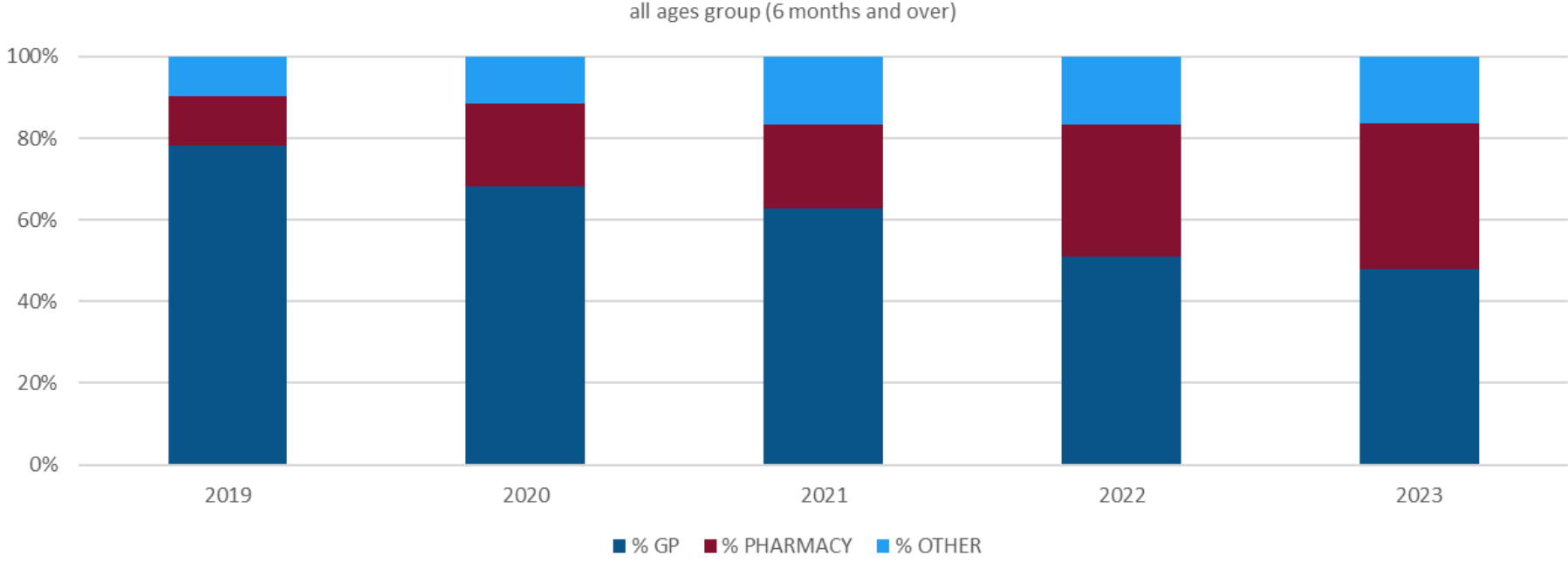

# Key Points

- Coverage in 2023 was lower compared to 2022, for all age groups.
- There was a marked increase in the proportion of influenza vaccines administered by pharmacists.
- Consider opportunities to promote vaccination in school-aged children, Aboriginal people and pregnant people.
