




COVID-19 in Western Australia The impact on other communicable diseases

Information on communicable diseases other than COVID-19 collected during January to September 2020 showed:

Influenza

Influenza remained at very low levels since April. The usual increase during winter was not seen in 2020.







Chickenpox decreased during March-April-May, during the most stringent lockdown measures, but has since returned to usual levels.



Salmonella infection stayed at usual levels throughout 2020.



Chlamydia decreased during March-April-May, during the most stringent lockdown measures, but has since returned to usual levels.



Dengue Fever has remained at very low levels since April.



Legionella increased during March-April-May, during the most stringent lockdown measures, but has since returned to usual levels.
